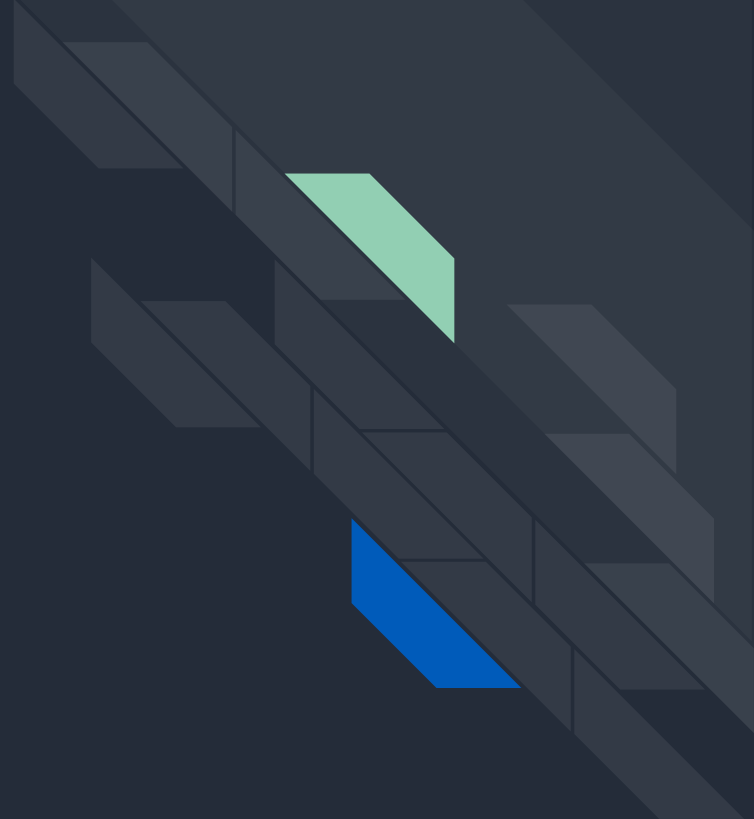

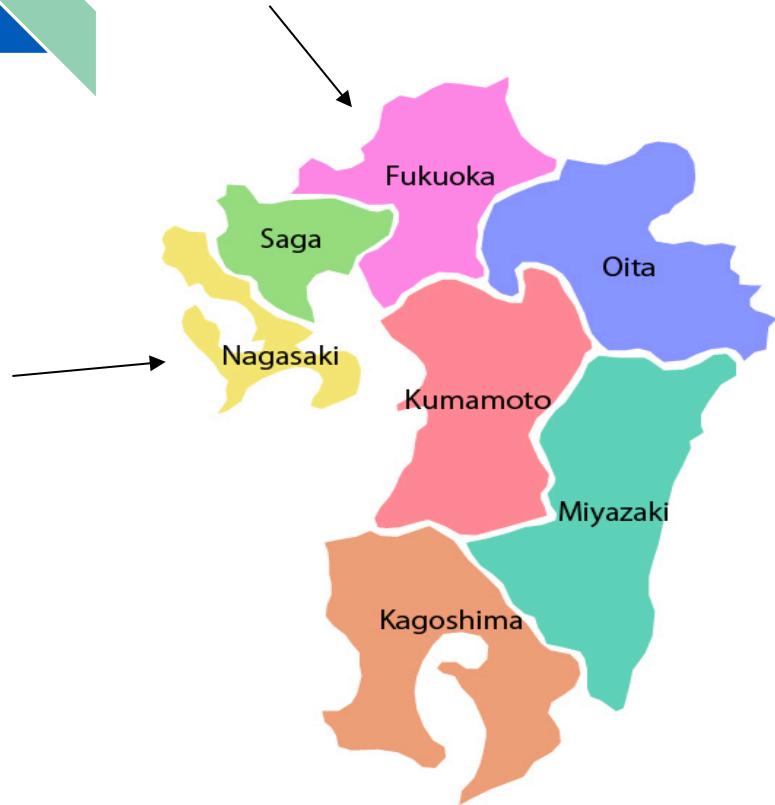

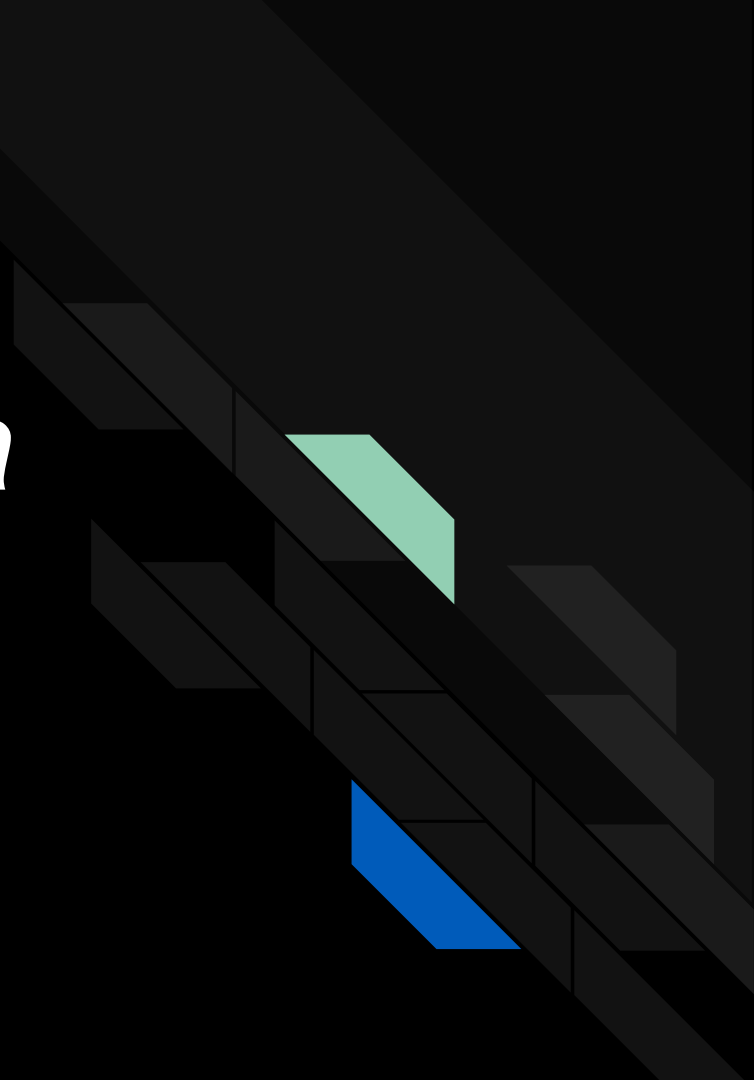


Map of Kyushu

Day #1 *Wednesday*, March 4th (Morning)

8:00: Meet at Narita Airport, at Terminal 1 on the 1st floor at arrival lobby

8:30: Check in

9:40 - 11:40:

Take the plane to Fukuoka Airport

11:40 - 12:30:

Get our luggage and get ready for the day

13:45 – 14:00: Check in Oriental Hotel (3 minutes walk), put luggage away

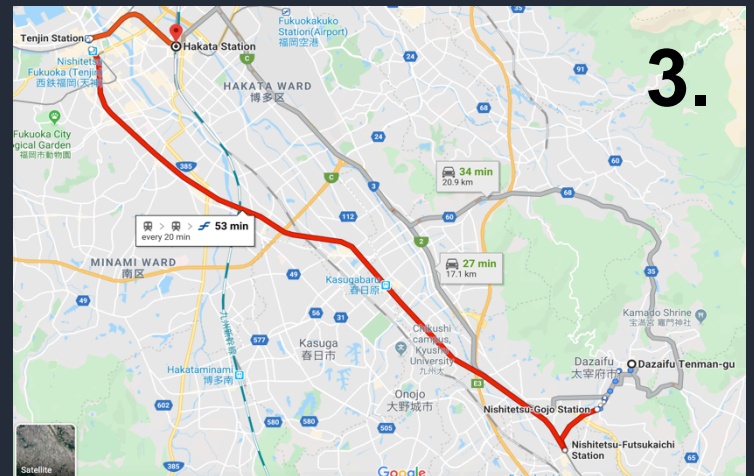
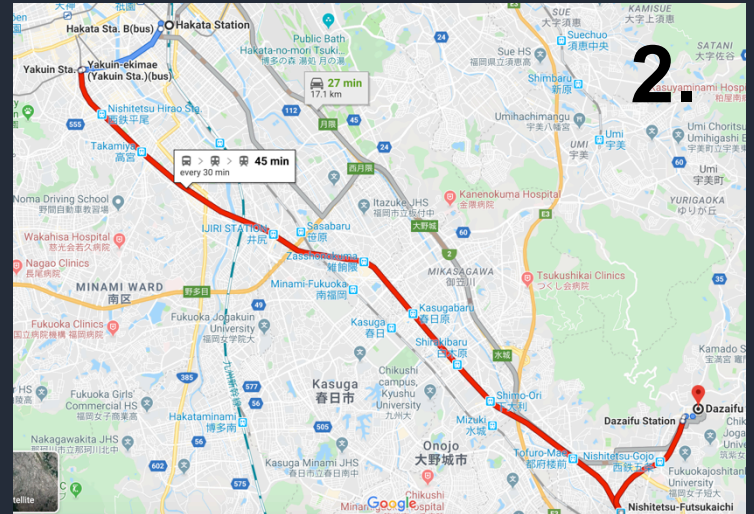
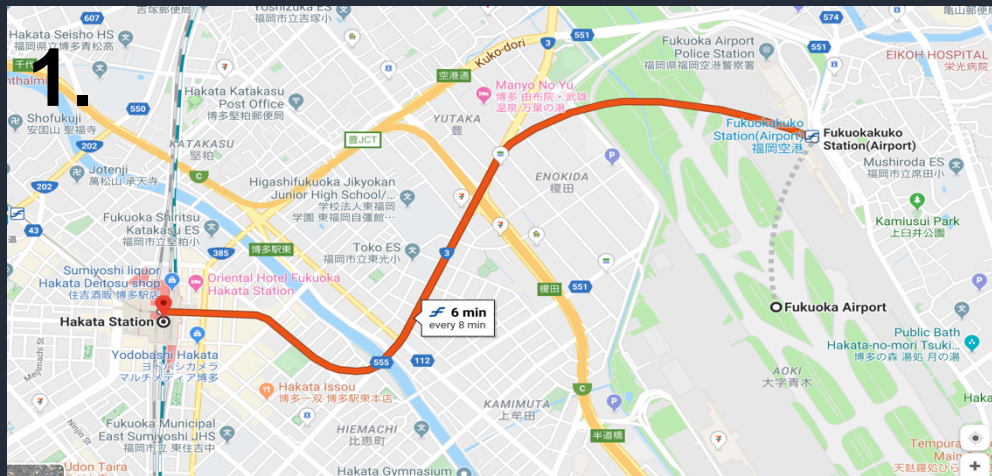
14:15 - 15:00: Hakata station - Dazaifu shrine (**45 minutes**, Cost - ¥ **410**)
(Nishitetsu-Tenjin-Omuta Line, Nishitetsu-Dazaifu Line, and Toei Bus)

15:00 – 16:30: Spend time at Dazaifu shrine (**1 hour 30 minutes**)

16:30 - 17:30: Dazaifu shrine – Hakata station (**1 hour**, Cost - ¥ **560**)
(Nishitetsu-Dazaifu Line, Nishitetsu-Tenjin-Omuta Line, and Kuko Line)

Routes:

1. Fukuoka Airport - Hakata Station
2. Hakata Station - Dazaifu Shrine & 3. back



Day #1 *Wednesday*, March 4th (Evening/Night)

17:30 - 17:45: Arrive at Canal City (**10 minutes** By walk from Hakata Station)

17:45 - 18:45: Spend time in Canal City (mall) (**1 hour**)

18:45 - 18:50: Walk to Yatai Stalls (**5 minutes**)

18:50 - 19:40: Have dinner (**Yatai Stalls**) (Cost - **¥ 1,000** per Yatai Cuisine)

19:40 - 20:00: Walk back to the Oriental Hotel (**20 minutes**)

20:00 - 22:30: Take a bath, brush your teeth, free time, head to sleep

3. Yatai Stalls - Oriental Hotel





(Kamome, Sasebo Line, and Omura Line)

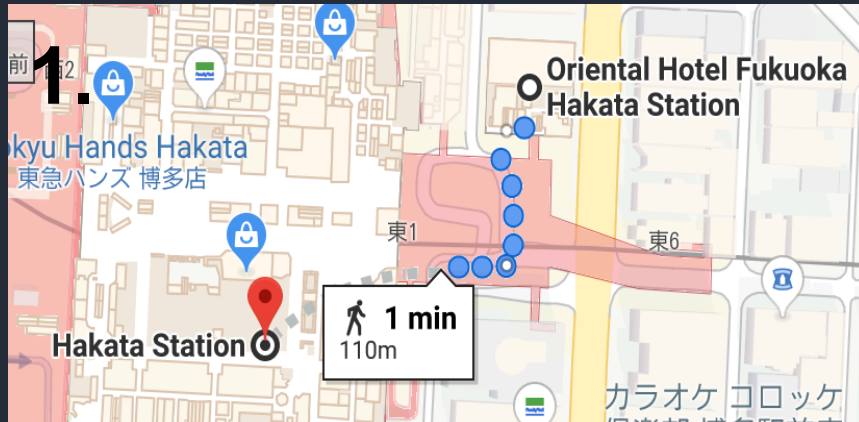
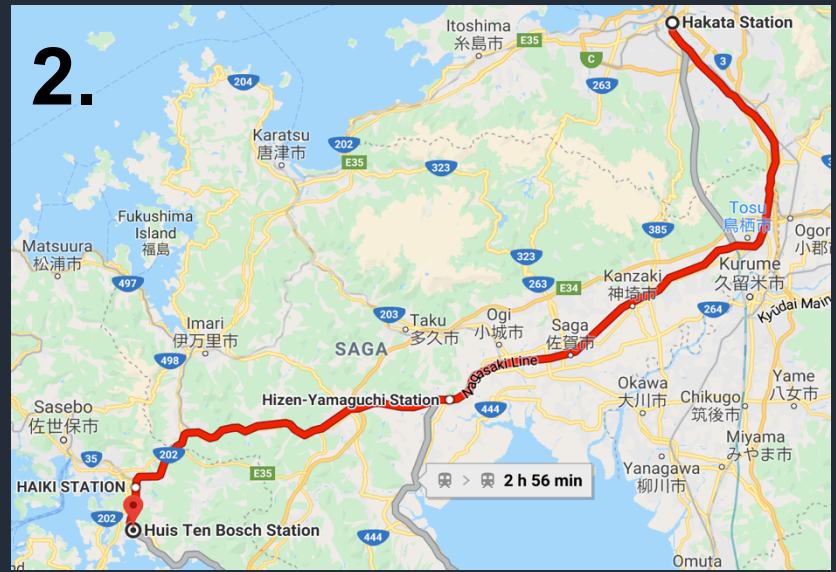
(**2 hours and 20 minutes**, Cost - ¥ 3,540)

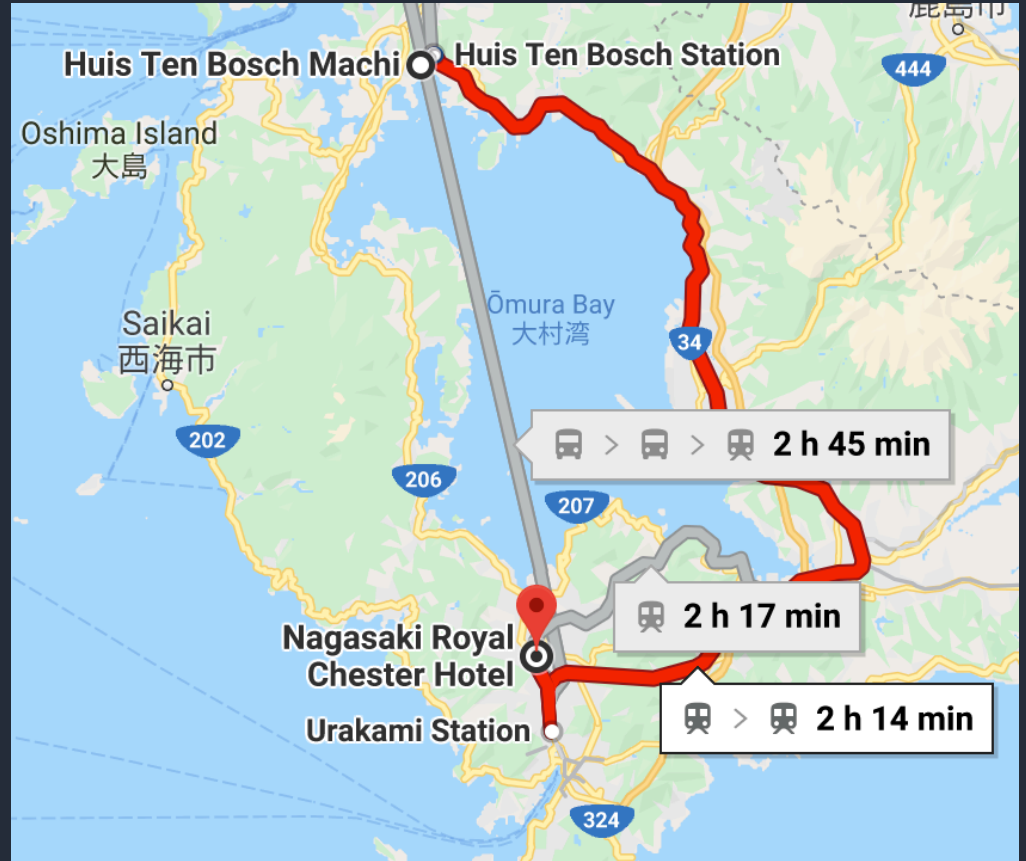

- Michinoo Station - Nagasaki Royal Chester Hotel



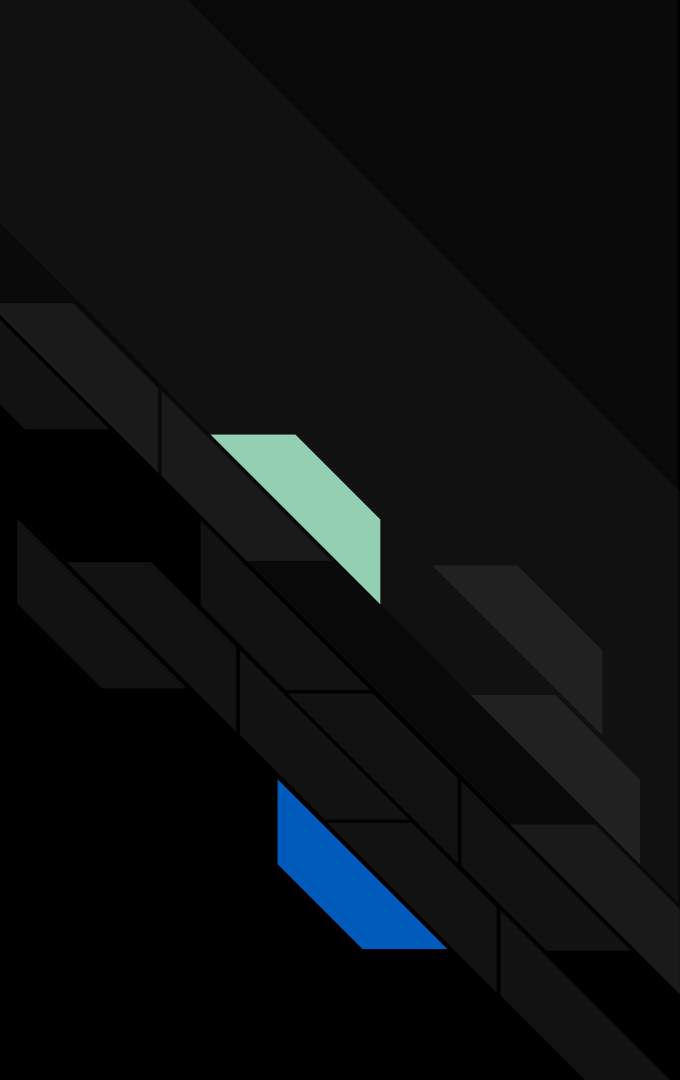

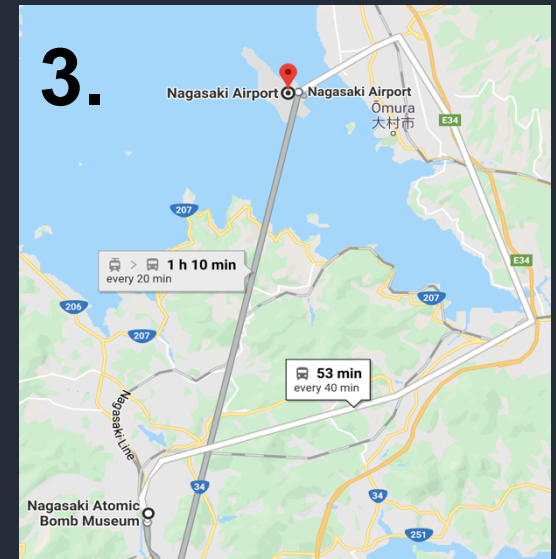
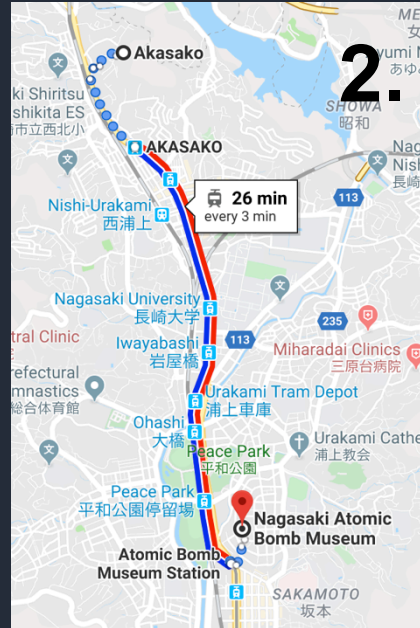
9:00 - 10:30: Spend time at Nagasaki Atomic Bomb Museum
